

3. Between the State and Private Companies: Managing Migratory and Crime Control at Guarulhos International Airport

This presentation focuses on the debate regarding technologies used for the management of national border spaces, especially considering those associating migratory control with crime control. Understanding technologies both as techniques and machinery, and focusing on the Guarulhos International Airport, the largest airport in Brazil, I conducted interviews with state agents who worked in this space, as well as carried on documentary research on policies implemented in this space. I will also expose methodological challenges for accessing people involved in the elaboration and implementation of these policies, as well as documents often considered sensitive.
